

IS THERE MONEY FOR INTERNET START-UPS IN SPAIN?

It seems so. Or that is what the numbers that it compiles seem to say [Loogic in this blog post](#) where he does a great review of The main investment operations in Spanish-speaking start-ups in the last year:

41 operations carried out compared to 37 in 2009 and 47 in 2008

4 total acquisition operations compared to 1 in 2009 and 10 in 2008.

520,280,000 euros of total investment compared to 85,700,000 in 2009 and 175 million in 2008, a very significant increase in investment, even discounting the 250 million from Edreams which would leave it at 270,280. 000 euro. **In 2010 three times as much was invested as in 2009** (according to the data we know)

This is not bad data for the Internet in what has been a disastrous year in many sectors.

Undoubtedly, these references can encourage a new generation of entrepreneurs in a sector that is beginning to have a certain entity in Spain and that presents enormous opportunities in a market, the Spanish-speaking market, which is global in nature.

On the other hand, ASCRI affirms that the Venture Capital investment [it doubled during 2010](#) having reached 3,435 million euros. Another good sign for innovation.
