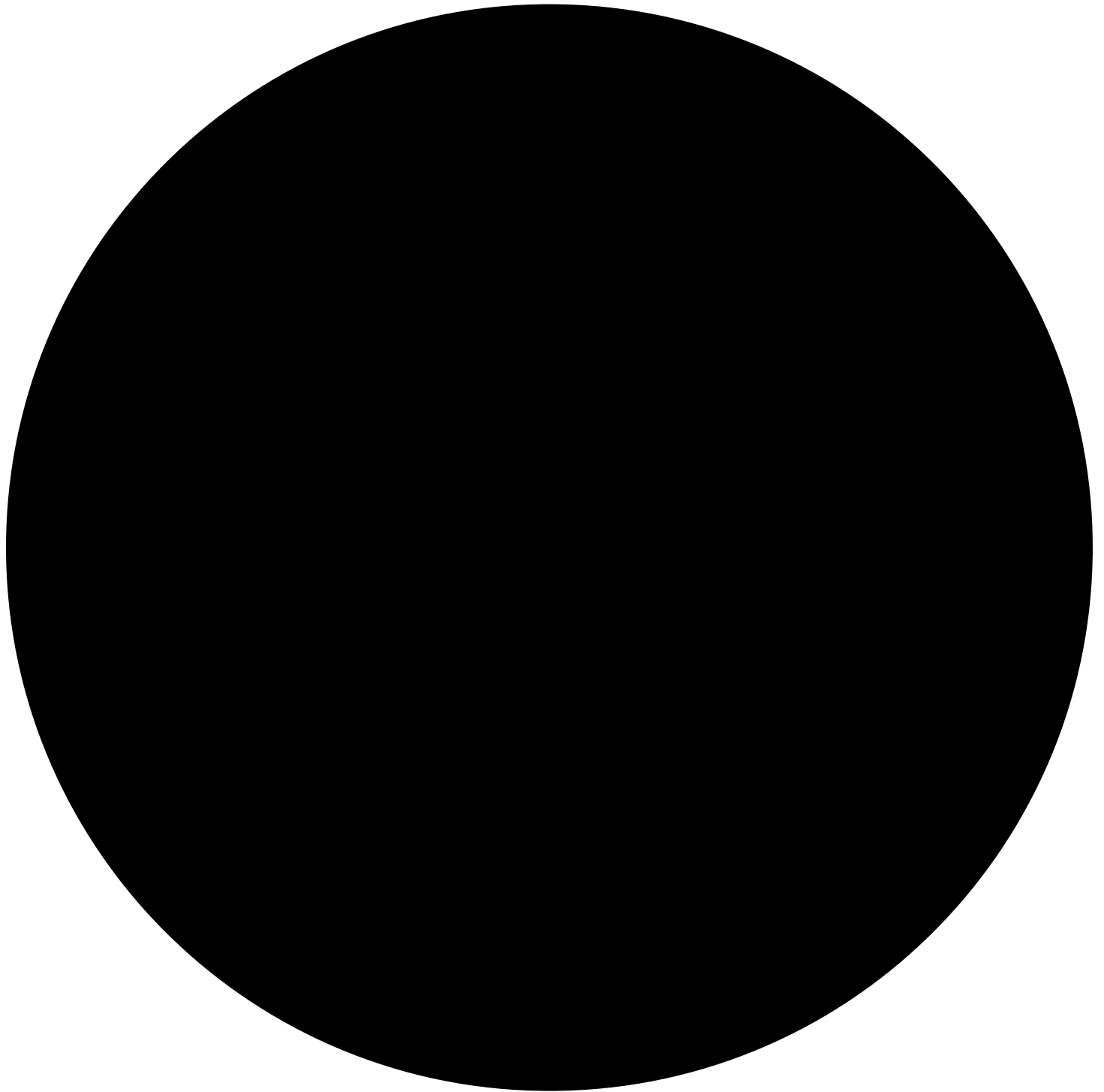


POLLUTION HAS MEASURE

When ecological awareness, will and technology come together [startups are born](#) such as the one created by two young Valencian women called AirVCL, this mobile application is capable of estimating harmful particles in up to 1,200 points in the Valencian community. For this, the tool does not require more than basic traffic data and weather conditions.

The purpose of knowing the areas most affected by pollution is none other than to provide information that could be useful to people who are more sensitive or sensitized to carbon dioxide particles.

In addition to the information provided by the application, the creators have introduced different categories based on the limits recommended by the World Health Organization (WHO), this application was presented last July in Lille (France) in it the owners from the firm also explained that their next objective is to launch another application that allows each user to measure the particular contamination of their vehicle.
