At the beginning of June, the European Commission highlighted the contribution of the Basque Country to the integration of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) at the territorial level in the application of public policies.



This is not the first time that the Commission highlights the work of the Basque Country in its initiatives governments around sustainable development. In 2020 the Commission and the OECD highlighted the trajectory in the Voluntary Follow-up reports (Voluntary Local Review) in which each territory reports progress in relation to the SDGs.
