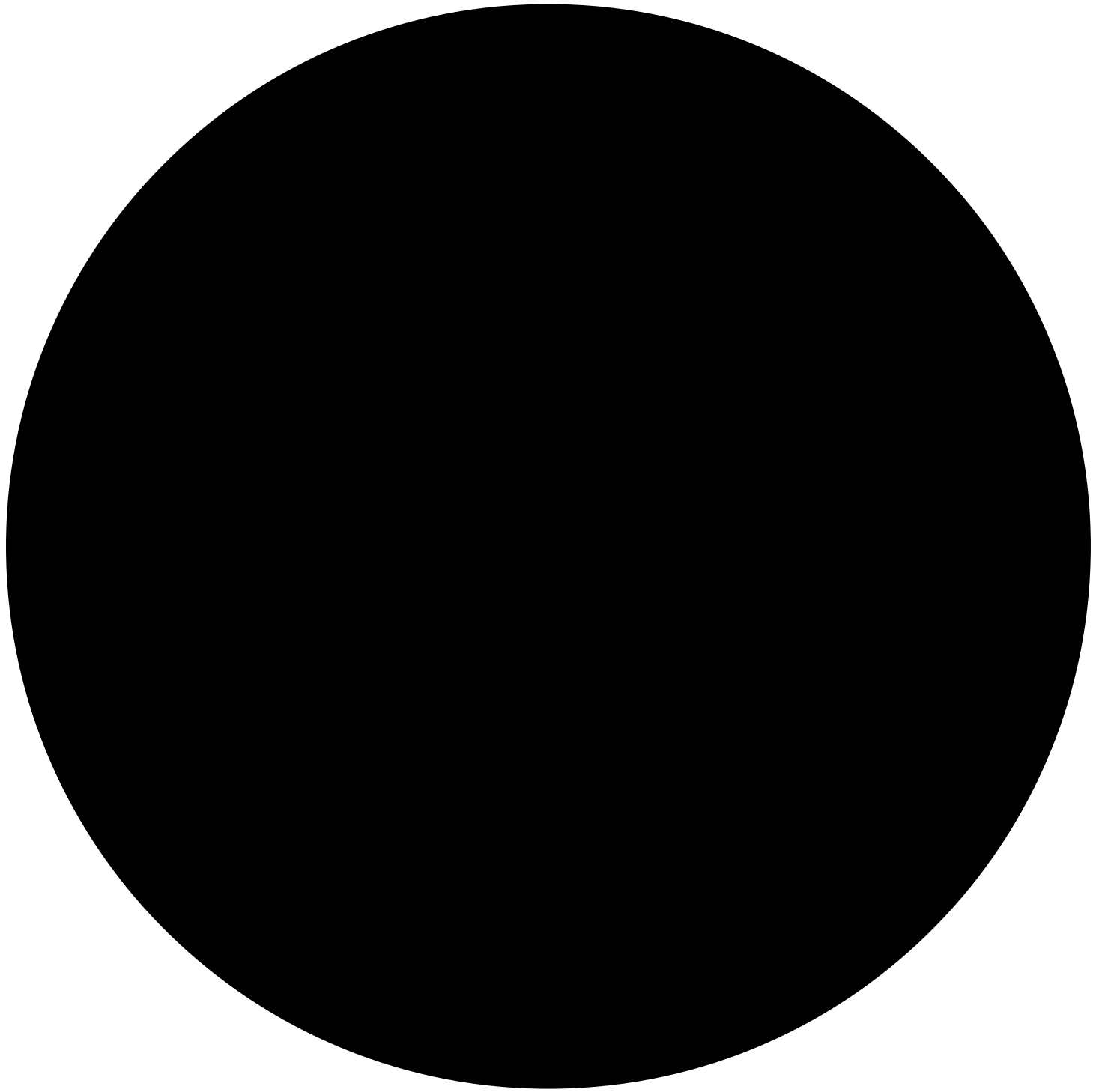


THE ENVIRONMENTAL CRISIS BEHIND THE ECONOMIC
