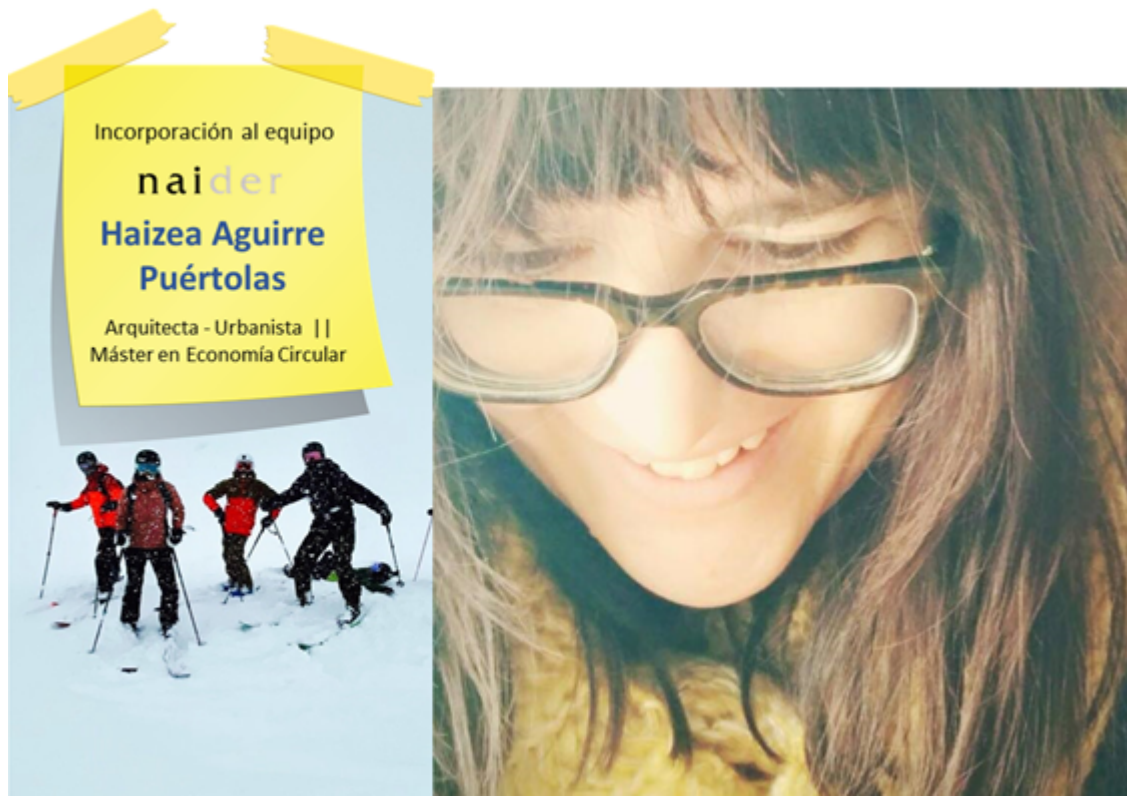


HAIZEA AGUIRRE, ARCHITECT - TOWN PLANNER, JOINS NAIDER TEAM
